- **1** Be very aware of free films that can be streamed / downloaded without payment or subscription
- **2** Be very aware of available films that are still in the cinemas this typically indicates that the film cannot be purchased or rented legally in Denmark yet
- **3** Check if the website where you want to watch / rent films from is an authorized distributor - for instance by searching the company name via Google
- 4 If you are in doubt as to whether the film is made available legally, avoid clicking "watch", "stream" or "download" film as this may constitute an infringement of the Copyright Act
- **5** Avoid downloading film files that contain words such as "torrent", "HDRip", "DVDRip" or similar words not usually associated with film titles
- 6 Make a critical assessment of the website where you want to watch films, and pay especially attention to language, design, access to film trailers, use of original film posters, etc.
- Make sure you secure your / home Internet connection with a password so others cannot use it for illegal file sharing / downloading of films without your knowledge
- 8 Make sure you know the users of your / household Internet connection, including who you share the Internet connection password with
- **9** Avoid file sharing services / networks like Popcorn Time, The Pirate Bay, BitTorrent, and others
- **10** Visit the website https://www.sharewithcare.dk/digitale-tjenester/ (in Danish) to view a list of legitimate services with films on the Internet
