Mogens has practiced as a lawyer in the United States for several years. He holds a Master of Laws (LL.M.) from the University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law, and a California bar license. During his years in the United States, he has specialized in advising companies on Danish-American legal matters. He therefore assists Danish clients with American interests in establishing American corporate structures, where both commercial, tax and liability limitation factors are considered. In addition, he regularly advises on the drafting and negotiation of commercial contracts as well as on dispute resolution, including instruction and supervision of litigation lawyers engaged on behalf of clients. He is thus highly specialized in cases concerning Danish-American and American-Danish legal matters.

Mogens is the author of the section on computer games in the textbook 'Entertainmentretten', whose current edition, 2nd edition, was published in 2021. The third edition is expected to be released during 2024. In addition, he is co-author of the section on Denmark in International Copyright Law, A Practical Global Guide, published by Globe Law and Business in 2022.
